**FINAL ASSESSMENT REPORT ON ICT, ENGLISH, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ORGANIC FOOD SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**

**By Portuguese Teachers**

In May 2023 students were administered a final questionnaire about English and ICT skills and competences, as well as entrepreneurship and organic food knowledge in order to know their final skills and competences and to check their improvement in the above-mentioned educational fields.

From direct observation, the questionnaires administered to students as well as the reports on the activities carried out, we can conclude that all the programs designed and carried out by the different countries throughout the project gave a very positive response to what was intended. The objectives of the Project were achieved and fulfilled what was intended when preparing the registration form and the respective application. Beside, the final curricula results confirm these data. We can say that the Project was a success and conclude that 100% of the students improved their skills in the three areas covered by the Project.

In all areas, the percentages of improvement of our students in the different skills acquired are indicated, in relation to the position they were in at the beginning of the project.

The low percentages of improvement in ICT and English are related to the very good level of development that our students already had, initially, in these skills.

However, with regard to entrepreneurship skills and organic food knowledge, the percentage values presented reflect well the great improvement that participants acquired throughout the Project. In detail here are the improvement percentages of the students involved in the project:

- 12% have improved their ICT skills;
- 15% have enhanced their English competences;
- 91% have increased entrepreneurship competences;
- 91% have developed organic food knowledge.
